



## HOW TO SIGN UP FOR A TRIP

**Current 2023-2024 membership is required to sign up for all trips (except Mystery).** Dues: \$10\* for returning members; \$30 for new or lapsed members. Renew/join at any General Meeting, or via mail.

Midwest trip sign ups open at 1pm at the Picnic, 8/6.  
Cruise, Warm Weather & Out West sign ups began.

**TRIP SIGN UP AT THE PICNIC:** Sunday, 8/6. Reserve your spot by being in line early!! **At 12 noon, at the picnic**, you can sign up for membership, then take your membership card and stand in line for the trip you're most interested in (*Please note: Trip lines can start forming before noon*). If you've already signed up for membership, go directly to the trip lines. **Be sure to bring your membership card!**

**FORMS/DEPOSITS:** For each trip you wish to attend: 1) Fill out and sign "Trip Information Sheet" - available online; 2) Write a deposit check; 3) Turn in forms/checks at the Picnic in August, bring to a General Meeting, or Mail to P.O. Box 207, Downers Grove, IL 60515.

**PAYMENTS:** Write 1 separate check per trip; indicate the destination in the memo line. You may combine payments for yourself and your roommate on the same trip, but do not combine payments for multiple trips. **All checks are made out to Piccadilly Ski Club; no cash or CC accepted.**

**ROOMMATES:** You may sign up yourself and one (1) other person, but they **MUST** be your roommate on that trip, and you both must be current 2023-2024 members. Indicate roommate preference on Trip Information Sheet. If you do not have one, every attempt will be made to match you up with the same gender. If one cannot be found by the cutback date, you have the option of paying the single supplement or cancelling from the trip and moving to the waitlist. (Your check will not be deposited until a roommate is found).

**EARLY BIRD RATES:** To qualify for the early bird pricing, the completed membership and trip forms and payments must be received by PSC or postmarked according to the following schedule:

Out West Trips: On or before the 9/7 General Meeting  
Midwest Trips: On or before the 12/7 General Meeting

**AFTER THE PICNIC**— Sign up for trips at a General Meeting, or by contacting the trip leader directly.

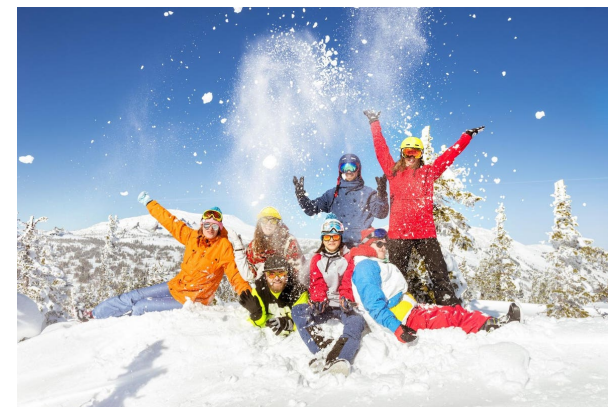
