



Focus on Giving

Piccadilly has always been a generous group. Periodically, we will focus on and share one member’s favorite charity; one which is close to their heart. Keep in mind PSC does not endorse any particular charity.



I, like many other Piccadillian’s in the past few years, had become “retired” and wondered what to do with my free time. I was looking for something new and different.

As I searched online, I came across the Honor Flight Network and found something really different. Their mission is to “Thank, Honor & Inspire”. The main idea is to fly senior veterans from WWII, Korean and Vietnam Wars to Washington DC for a day to visit the memorials that honor them for their service. This day of honor is fueled by donations and volunteers so there is absolutely no cost for the Vets.

I have many friends and relatives that have been in the military and have always been amazed by their personal bravery and sacrifice. I can’t even imagine what that feels like, but I’ve always been grateful, and this is my chance to give back to all of them.



I have several friends whose Dad or husbands had been on an honor flight and heard nothing but praise about this life changing day. I joined this group at the start of their season last year and WOW I was blown away by all they do. My check-in at 2:45 am at MDW to greet the Vets, check them in and hear their stories is amazing! I love seeing all the photos of everything Honor Flight does to make this such a special day for the Vets. Take a look at the hundreds of photos and videos of their full day online. The time also flies, and this group is run like a well-oiled machine, before you know it I'm back at MDW with their families to welcome them home at the approximate 8:30pm arrival. None of them ever seem to mind the long day, they come home smiling ear to ear during the parade down the concourse led by bagpipes and escorted by sailors. The Chicago hub has been around for 15 years and served over 10,000 Vets on 107 flights, for free!



My Dad was a Korean War Vet; he passed away a few years before they started Honor Flight. I'm pretty sure he had seen some of the memorials in DC but what I really wish is that he could have experienced the camaraderie and honor that these participants experience, that's what makes their day and mine. Trips are flown monthly from Chicago, April - October.

Bill & Ted’s Excellent Kayak Adventure (V) The Whitewater Festival Tour, Saturday, 7/15, 9am

Bill & Ted are back for another Excellent Kayak Adventure on the Fox River on Saturday July 15th. Join us for this special “Whitewater Festival Tour” which will end at the Yorkville Hometown and Whitewater Festival at Bicentennial Riverfront Park, where we can enjoy Crafts, Food & Beer Vendors, and live music. Non-water going folks are welcome to join us at the festival at the end of the trip. This year’s Kayak Adventure will run from the Montgomery Dam to the Yorkville Dam. Expect a leisurely and scenic cruise down the Fox River. Don’t be surprised if you catch sight of Bald Eagles flying above us. Be surprised if you encounter any rapids. The only whitewater on the river is the whitewater course just past our takeout point at Yorkville. Expect the adventure to last four to five hours.



Plan to meet at 9:00 AM at the Yorkville Dam at Bicentennial Riverfront Park in Yorkville, IL (the trip endpoint). From there, we will coordinate shuttling everyone to the start point at the Montgomery Dam. We plan to put in just below the Montgomery Dam at South Broadway Park in Montgomery IL. Our lunch stop will be at Hudson Crossing Park in Oswego IL. Paddlers must supply their own food, water, and other beverages for the entire journey. Feel free to bring along any fun props or Kayak decorations to bring on the water for the trip. Both porta potties and potable water are available at the lunch stop. We will take out just above the Yorkville Dam at Bicentennial Riverfront Park in Yorkville.



The Yak Shack has 15 Kayaks reserved for Piccadilly on that day. It will be first come, first serve for the kayak availability. There are also 20 canoes available for rental if a canoe is desired or if the Kayaks are sold out.

To reserve your Kayak or Canoe, you must call the Yak Shack directly at (630) 479-8074 to make your reservation for Saturday July 15th and tell them you are with “Piccadilly Ski Club” to get the

bargain rate of \$35 for Kayak rentals and \$50 for two-person canoe rentals. Each attending member will be responsible for reserving and paying for their own kayak rental through the Yak Shack. The 15 Kayaks will be reserved for Piccadilly until July 1st. After that date, unreserved kayaks will be opened up for public rental. As our trip will coincide with the Whitewater Festival, Kayaks will likely sell out after July 1st if Piccadilly members have not reserved them. The rental will include Lifejackets, Paddles and delivery and pickup of the watercraft (we will be transporting the paddlers). Jeff at the Yak Shack will be able to tell you how many watercraft are still available when you call.



Excellent!

Once you have reserved your Kayak, please sign up on Meetup, which will give others an idea of who is planning to go. If you have your own watercraft, we encourage you to join our trip at no cost, though you will be responsible for coordinating the drop off and pick up of your own watercraft. If you do plan to bring your own watercraft, please sign up on meetup with the comments of "Bringing my own Kayak or Canoe." The trip will go rain or shine, in the absence of lightning.
